

**All Scripture Sermon**  
**“THE REAL CHRISTMAS STORY”**

Genesis 1:1-3

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, ‘Let there be light and there was light.’”

Vs. 10 “And God called the dry land Earth; the waters He called seas: and God saw that it was good.”

Vs. 21 “And God created great whales, and every creature that moveth, that the waters brought forth abundantly, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good. And God made the beasts of the earth after their kind, and cattle after their kind, and every thing that creepeth upon the earth after their kind: and God saw that it was good.”

Vs. 26 And God said, ‘Let us make man in our own image.’ ”So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created he them.”

Genesis 2:7, “And God formed man from the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.”

Vs. 18, “And God said, ‘It is not good that man should be alone; I will make a help meet for him.’”

Vs. 24, “Therefore, shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife and they two shall be one flesh.”

Genesis 3:11-13, “And God said, “Who told you that you were naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree that I commanded you that you shouldn’t? And the man said, The woman who thou gavest me, she gave me and I

did eat. And the Lord said unto the woman, What have you done? And the woman said, 'The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.'"

Vs. 15, "And God said to the serpent, "I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heal."

Vs. 23, "Therefore the Lord God sent them forth from the garden of Eden."

Genesis 6:5, "And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the Lord that He made man."

Genesis 6:14, "Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shall pitch it within and without with pitch."

Genesis 6:17, "And behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh and everything thing that is in the earth shall die."

Genesis 7:1, "And the Lord said unto Noah, 'Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for in thee have I seen righteousness before Me in this generation.'"

Genesis 18:1, "And the Lord appeared to Abraham in the plains of Mamre; and he sat in the tent in the heat of the day."

Vs. 11, "Now, Abraham and Sarah were old and well stricken in years; and it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women."

Vs. 14, "Is anything too hard for the Lord? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son."

Genesis 21:1, "And the Lord did unto Sarah as he had said. Sarah conceived, and bare Abraham a son in his old age,..."

Genesis 22:1-2, “And it came to pass after these things that God tempted Abraham and said unto him, take thine only son Issac, whom thou loveth, to the land of Moriah and offer him there for a burnt offering.”

Vs. 10-11, “And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the angel of the Lord said, “Lay not thine hand upon the lad, for I know that thou fearest God, seeing that though hast not withheld thy only son from Me.”

Vs. 18, “God said to Abraham, “And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.”

JEREMIAH 31:31-33, “Behold the days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Isreal, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand and led them out of Egypt; But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Isreal; After those days, saith the Lord, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and I will be their God and they shall be My people.”

HEBREWS 8:13, “A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxed old is ready to vanish away.”

ISAIAH 2:2-4, “And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the house of the Lord shall be established at the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow into it. And many people shall say, ‘Come, let us go up into the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; and He shall teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.’”

ISAIAH 35:5-10, “Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then shall the lame leap like a deer, and

the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert. And a highway shall be there and a way, and it shall be called the way of holiness. And the ransomed of the Lord shall return, and come to Zion with sons with everlasting joy on their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall go away.”

Micah 5:2, “But thou Bethlehem, though thou be little, yet out of thee shall He come forth, the ruler of Isreal...”

ISAIAH 11:1-6, “And there shall come forth a rod, out of the stem of Jesse, a Branch shall grow out of his roots: And the spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord;...”  
“Faithfulness and strength shall be in his reins.”

ISAIAH 7:14, “Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive and bring forth a son and shall call His name Immanuel.”

ISAIAH 9:6, “For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given, and the government shall be upon His shoulders and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace.”

MATTHEW 1:18-22, “Now the birth of Jesus was like this: When His mother Mary was espoused to Joseph before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. Joseph, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a spectacle, was minded to put her away secretly. But, while he thought on these things, behold the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, ‘Joseph, son of David, fear not to take Mary unto thee as thy wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call His name Jesus, for He shall save His people from their sins.’”

LUKE 2:8-12, “And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto us a child is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord.

LUKE 2:40-52, “And the child grew in spirit and in wisdom and the grace of God was upon Him.

MATTHEW 3:1-2, “In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness, saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

MATTHEW 3:13-17, “Then came Jesus from Galilee to Jordan to be baptized of John. But, John stopped him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and you come to me? And Jesus said, “Suffer it to be so.” And when Jesus was baptized, lo, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him and a voice from heaven saying, “This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”

Matthew 4:1-4, “Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He was an hungered. And the tempter came to him and said, ‘If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.’ But he said, it is written, man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.”

MATTHEW 5:1-10, “And seeing the multitudes, He went up into the mountain and when he was set therein, His disciples came unto him; And He taught them saying,  
Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of God  
Blessed are they that mourn; for they shall be comforted.  
Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled.

Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy.

Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Blessed are the peacemakers; for they shall be called the children of God.

Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness sake: for theirs is the kingdom of God.”

MATTHEW 5:13-16, “Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost it’s savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and trodden under the foot of man. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”

MATTHEW 6:19-21, “Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt and where thieves break through and steal. But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through and steal. For where your treasure is there your heart will be also.”

MATTHEW 6:24, “No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love the other or he will love the one and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.”

MATTHEW 6:33, “Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you.”

MATTHEW 7:7, “Ask and it shall be given unto you, seek and ye shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you.”

MATTHEW 7:13-14, “Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way that leadeth to destruction and many there be that

findeth thereat. But straight is the gate and narrow is the way that leadeth unto life and few there be that findeth.”

MATTHEW 7:21, “Not everyone that says unto me Lord, Lord shall enter into the Kingdom of heaven, but he that doth the will of my Father which is in heaven.”

JOHN 3:1-5, “There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we now that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do the miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. Jesus answered and said unto him, “Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.” Nicodemus said, How can a man be born when he is old, can he enter in the second time into his mother’s womb and be born? Jesus said, “Verily, verily I say unto thee Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.”

JOHN 3:16-17, “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world but that the world through Him might be saved.”

MATTHEW 11:28-30, “Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me, for I am meek and lowly in heart and you shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

JOHN 10:11, “I am the good shepherd: the good shephard layeth His life down for the sheep.”

JOHN 14:6, “I am the way, the truth and the life, no man cometh unto the Father but by Me.” “I am the resurrection and the life.”

JOHN 14:15, “If you love Me, keep My commandments.”

Matthew 26:21, “I say unto you, that one of you shall betray Me.”

JOHN 14:1-3, “Let not your hearts be troubled, you believe in God, believe also in Me. For in My Father’s house are many mansions if it were not so I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you and if I go and prepare a place for you I will come again and receive you unto Myself that where I am there ye may be also.”

MATTHEW 26:38-39, “Then He said to them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: stay with Me, and watch with Me. And He went a little farther, and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, “Father, if it be possible let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not My will but Thine be done.”

John 19:16, “Then delivered he him to be crucified.”

LUKE 23:34, “Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.”

LUKE 23:43, “Today, You will be with Me in Paradise.”

JOHN 19:26-27, “Woman, behold thy son; woman behold thy mother.”

MARK 15:34, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

JOHN 19:28, “I thirst.”

JOHN 19:30, “It is finished.”

LUKE 23:46, “Father, into Thy hands I commend My spirit.”

John 1:1-4, “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him: and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.”

Vs. 14, “And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.”  
“He came unto His own and His own received Him not.”



ISAIAH 53:3-5, “He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief, and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. Surely, he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:...

“He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.”

MARK 15:43, “Joseph of Arimathaea came boldly to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus.”

MARK 15:46, “He took Him down, and wrapped Him in a linen and laid Him in a sepulcher which was cut out of a rock, and a stone was rolled in front of the door.”

MARK 16:2-6, “And very early in the morning on the first day of the week, they came unto the tomb at the rising of the sun. And when they looked, they saw that the stone was rolled away; for it was very great. And entering into the sepulcher, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were amazed. And he said unto them, ‘Be not afraid, Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: He is risen, He is not here.’”

MATTHEW 28:18-20, “Then Jesus said unto them, “Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the age.”

Mark 16:15-16, “Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved.”

ACTS 1:9, “And when He had spoken these things, while they beheld, He was taken up; and a cloud received Him out of their sight.”

Acts 2: And when the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as a rushing mighty wind and it filled the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire and set upon each of them and they were filled with the Holy Ghost and began speaking in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.” And there were dwelling in Jerusalem, Jews, devout men, out of every nation.” And they were all amazed, saying to one another what meanest this?

Vs. 13, “Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.”

Vs. 14-16, “But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted his voice and said unto them, Ye men of Judea, and all that dwell in Jerusalem, be it known unto you and hearken to my words: For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel:”

Vs. 22, “Ye men of Isreal, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did by Him in the midst of you, as ye yourself also know:”

Vs. 23, “Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and with wicked hands have crucified and slain:”

Vs. 37, “Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their hearts and said unto Peter and the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?”

Vs. 38, “Peter said unto them, Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” “And that day there were added unto them about 3,000 souls.”

Vs. 47, “Praising God and having favor with all the people, and the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.”

I CORINTHIANS 15:1-4, “Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you and that also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved if you keep in memory the things that I preached unto you, unless you believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures and that He was buried and that He rose again the third day according to the scriptures.”

ACTS 16:30-31, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, ‘Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.’”

LUKE 13:3, “I tell ye nay but accept you repent you shall all likewise perish.”

ROMANS 10:10, “For with a heart man believeth unto righteousness and with a mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

ROMANS 6:4, “Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

REVELATION 22:17, “The Spirit and the Bride say come. Let him that heareth say come. And whosoever will let him take the water of life freely.”

I John 1:7, “But, if we walk in the light as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.”

Galatians 1:8, “But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any

other gospel unto you than that which ye have received, let him be accursed.”

ROMANS 1:16, “For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ. For it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”

HEBREWS 11:6, “For without faith it is impossible to please God for he that cometh unto God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.”

II CORINTHIANS 5:7, “For we walk by faith, not by sight:”

Romans 3:23, “For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God.”

Romans 6:23, “For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

II TIMOTHY 4:2-8, I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing, Preach the Word, be instant in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. Revelation 2:10, “Be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.”
